Tri Group Meeting: Report from meeting of Chamber of Commerce, JB Tourism and HWCV to discuss Huskisson priority projects including Owen Street upgrade. Suggestion from meeting that Northern side of Owen Street to be added to list.

General Business

Resident's Expectations for Huskisson: Motion that HWCV form a *temporary* sub-committee to articulate the expectations/aspirations that Huskisson residents have for the future growth/development of their town with particular reference to the use of public space for events. Recommendations from this *temporary* sub-committee to be presented to a *full meeting* of HWCV for approval/discussion. Moved/Seconded (Penny Davidson/Jan Bruck). Motion passed.

Project Officer: Clr Jo Gash advised that Council will be appointing a Project Officer to assist residents with problem solving issues regarding traffic, tourism etc. The Officer's services will be available to all Shoalhaven communities.

'About' Magazine: Jan Bruck was authorised to submit a summary/precis of the Minutes of HWCV meetings for publication in 'About' magazine with the objective of increasing our profile in the community.

Roundabout: Clr Jo Gash is hopeful of receiving \$25,000 to enable a design to be prepared for a roundabout at the corner of Sydney & Owen Streets, outside the Picture Theatre.

Anglican Church, Cnr Hawke & Bowen Streets: Heritage listing on the church building was lifted many years ago. The church has recently been de-consecrated and has now been sold. Concern about the possibility of the land being sold for development and the prospect of high rise on this site is very real. Clr Gash advised there is no DA in Council yet. GK advised that HWCV is unable to prevent the Church from disposing of their land. Important to note that the back area of the block bordering Currumbene Street is *Crown* land.

Woollamia Rd/Goodlands Rd, rubbish/old caravans: Query from resident on what can be done. GK advised to contact the Shoalhaven Ranger.
